

Classroom Discussion Questions for DREAMER

1. What do you think Jessa has learned about herself since book one?
2. If you could meet another version of yourself – one who ended up on a different life path – what would you ask them?
3. Do you think it was right for Mario to allow Jessa (and Finn) into someone else's dreams?
4. Do you think Jessa really gave her relationship with Ben a chance?
5. We learn that Mario hasn't always been as careful as he could be with his Travelers. Do you think he's unnecessarily reckless? Or does a certain amount of risk just come with being a Traveler?
6. Finn takes Jessa to see a real, live Mammoth in an alternate reality. What extinct creature would you like to visit in another reality, if you could?
7. Jessa learns that she's been a magician's assistant and a circus performer. What career do you think you could have, in an alternate life?
8. Ben and Olivia both encourage Jessa to reach out, and not be such an introvert. Do you think it's hard for her to get out of her own story-fueled world and make an effort to be more of a friend to people?
9. Family is important to Jessa, but also a cause of stress in her daily life. Does becoming a Traveler make that even harder for her to balance? And how can she manage it better?
10. Ben's subconscious was set up like a museum. What do you think the set of your subconscious would look like?
